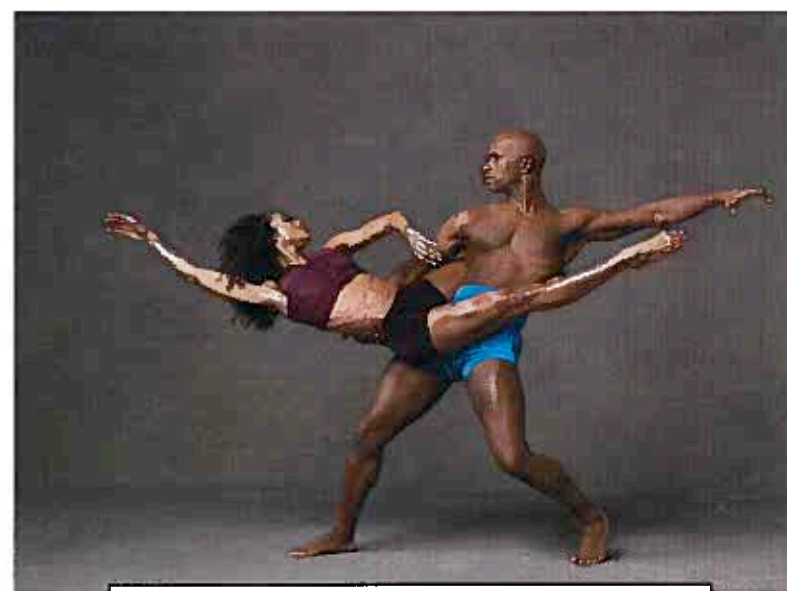

Original jazz compositions by the musical iconoclast Eric Lewis and costumes by the award-winning designer Paul Tazewell are inspired by a series of Jamison's own drawings that depict these characters' ordinary and sometimes extraordinary lives.

Alvin Ailey said that one of America's richest treasures was the cultural heritage of the African-American – "sometimes sorrowful, sometimes jubilant, but always hopeful." This enduring classic is a tribute to that heritage and to Ailey's genius.
